Membership

Section 3. Withdrawal and Removal (Under B.)

- A. A member may withdraw from the Association by presenting his/her resignation in writing to the Board of Directors. Any member who fails to pay his/her membership dues shall forfeit membership to the Association.
- B. Any member may be removed by a two-thirds vote of the full board members present at any properly called meeting for conduct deemed detrimental to the Association, provided however, that such member shall first have been given an opportunity to be heard at the meeting at which such vote is taken. A minimum of 75% of board members must be in attendance at this meeting. These provisions shall apply to the removal of Directors as well as regular members.
