



A nationally recognized model that helps youth with significant behavioral, emotional and mental health issues to remain in the community by creating an individualized support plan for the family.

Supervised Parenting & Safe Exchange **612.877.7846**

In cases of family separation or family violence where the well-being of the child is in question, non-custodial parents and their children can visit in a safe environment in the home, out in the community or at one of our sites.
